#### Student Supply List

Art clothes or apron and comfortable shoes

1 plastic tote bin and lid – Approximately **24” x 18” x 6”**

Craft scissors

Permanent marker

1 large plastic bag (lawn & garden size)

Roll of paper towels

Clamps - 4” and 6” spring clamps – plastic works best. (Check the big orange box store, dollar stores, and [pjtool.com](http://pjtool.com) for best prices) The more you have, per template the better your resist. Try for at least 15 to 20 different clamps.



We will complete 90% of this project in class, but there will be rinsing and washing assigned as “Homework.” We are, after all, holding a dye class in a rather unusual location. Don’t fret - this is actually the fun part where you get to see your results!

We will wrap your project up in the bin, placed inside the plastic bag for safe transportation. There will be a few flat bed carts available, but many students choose to bring their own.

This is a fairly easy rinse that can easily be accomplished in half an hour to 45 minutes after allowing this project “batch” for a minimum of 8 hours and up to 24 for the richest colors results.
